Welcome to the 2020 Bay to Birdwood

COVIDSAFE GUIDELINES

The 2020 Bay to Birdwood will be presented as a COVIDSafe Event. Attendance at the Start and Finish will be restricted to occupants of entrant vehicles and event team members only, and not open to members of the public.

DO NOT ATTEND ANY BAY TO BIRDWOOD ACTIVITIES IF YOU:

- are feeling unwell or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms (fever or chills; cough or shortness of breath; loss of taste or smell)
- are awaiting results of a COVID-19 test, or someone in your household is awaiting results of a COVID-19 test
- are under instruction to self-isolate or quarantine, or someone in your household is in self-isolation or quarantine
- have had contact with a person who is an active confirmed or suspected COVID-19 case.

CONTACT TRACING DETAILS AND A WELLBEING DECLARATION ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL ATTENDEES

Contact tracing information will be requested in advance, and will only be used for tracing purposes.

WHEN ATTENDING THE EVENT, THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES MUST BE FOLLOWED BY ALL ATTENDEES:

- Observe and maintain physical distancing (at least 1.5 metres) from all persons, beyond those you arrived with.
- Avoid physical greetings such as handshaking, hugs and kisses.
- Remain within your vehicle as much as practicable.
- Practice regular hand hygiene.
- Practice good sneeze and cough hygiene.
- Observe the safety signage throughout the site.
- Follow the directions of traffic marshals, COVID marshals and event staff.
- Observe all pathway and queue markers where applicable.
- Use the bins provided for the disposal of rubbish.
- Alert security staff if you have any concerns regarding attendee behaviour or wellness.

The Parade of Historic Motoring will proceed along a 72 kilometre route, from Barratt Reserve to the National Motor Museum at Birdwood.

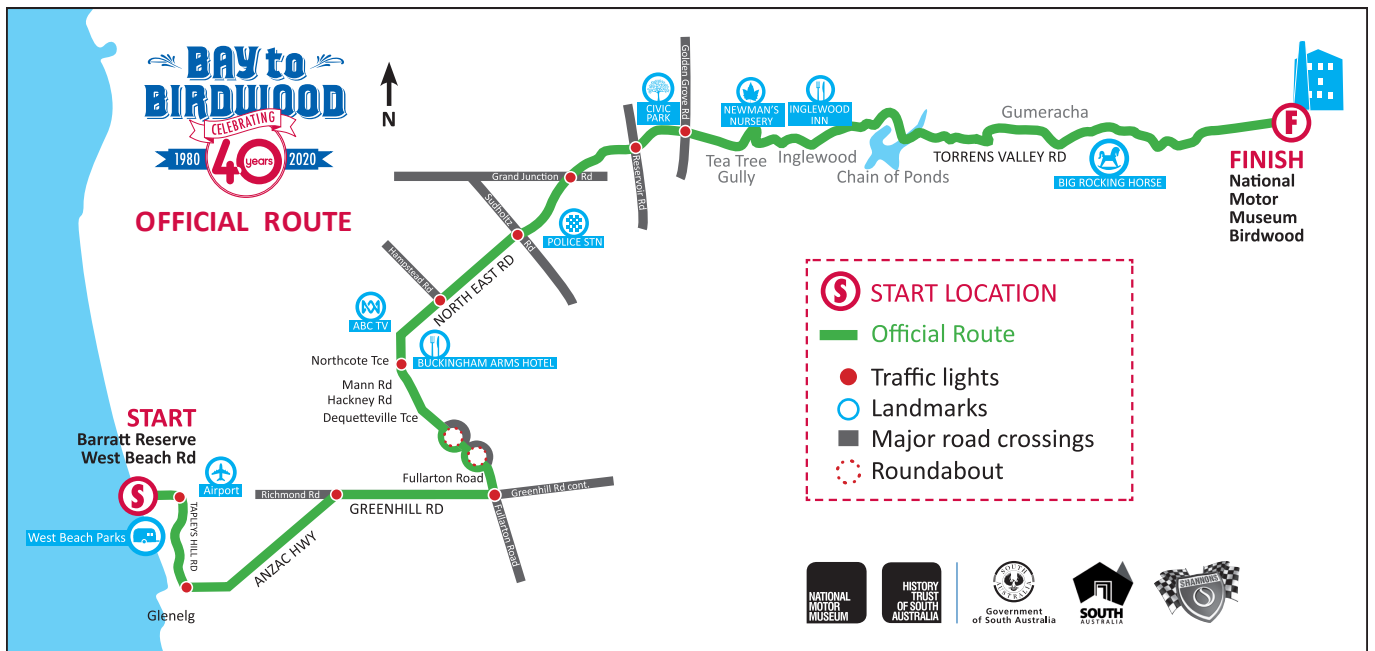
