IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL ENTRANTS

POLICE ADVICE AND SAFETY NOTICE

Normal traffic light sequences and traffic rules apply along the route.

Entrants are reminded to:

- Use all lanes available to prevent congestion.
- Overtake slower event vehicles. Exercise caution when overtaking.
- Observe signposted speeds and follow directions on all signs.
- Obey instructions of SA Police and Bay to Birdwood official marshals.

VEHICLE ASSISTANCE

Vehicle assistance will be provided by RAA Road Service (along the route and at sites) and Women for Wheels (at the Start site).

Contact RAA Roadside Assistance 13 11 11 if needed.

REST STOP

Civic Park, Modbury is a designated rest stop for participants where coffee, a community BBQ and toilets will be available.

Civic Park is off North East Road. Look out for signs and refer to the map of the Alternative Start on the next page.

Please enter the carpark slowly and follow marshal directions.



THE FINISH

APPROACHING BIRDWOOD

Turn **LEFT** onto Warren Road. Follow the event signs and marshals directions into Church Street for the finish line and collect your plaque.

PLAQUE COLLECTION

Your commemorative plaque will be handed to you on Church Street at the Finish line. If you arrive after 2:00 pm please go to the Event Office on the Motor Museum grounds to collect your plaque. Motorbike entrants can also collect the plaque at the Event Office after parking inside the grounds.

After collecting your plaque, you have two options:

Option 1: JOIN THE DISPLAY ON THE GROUNDS OF THE NATIONAL MOTOR MUSEUM AND JOIN IN THE FINISH FESTIVAL CELEBRATIONS

Proceed along Church Street to enter the museum grounds via the Church St Gate, follow the directions of marshals at all at times. Once on the Motor Museum grounds, vehicles are to remain on display for the hundreds of visitors attending until at least 2:30 pm.

Option 2: IF YOU ARE NOT GOING TO JOIN THE DISPLAY AT THE FINISH FESTIVAL (DISPLAY THE 'U' CARD)

Should you not wish to be part of the display, after collecting the commemorative plaque, display the 'U' CARD on your windscreen and follow the directions on the back of the 'U' CARD and the marshals who will direct you out of Birdwood.

FINISH FESTIVAL

This year, the Finish Festival is back on the National Motor Museum grounds with entertainment, Fashions on the Field and food & beverage.

Tickets to the Finish Festival

VEHICLE ENTRANTS: As an entrant your event registration includes admission to the Finish Festival at Birdwood and for all legally seated occupants in your vehicle. You and your passenger(s) must enter the Museum via the Church Street Gate in your vehicle.

BIKE ENTRANTS: As an entrant your event registration includes admission to the Finish Festival at Birdwood for you and a pillion passenger. All motorbike entrants also receive two complimentary tickets to the Finish Festival.

Fashions on the Field

A competition for best period costume will take place at the Finish Festival, with categories for male, female, and group fashion. We encourage all vehicle entrants to get involved and into the spirit of the event, whether you enter the fashion competition or not. Register for the competition at the Finish Festival Event Office from 10.30 am on the event day. The parade and judging will take place at 1.00 pm.



ENTRANT STICKER

The Entrant Sticker identifies your vehicle as a Bay to Birdwood participant. It provides key information for traffic marshals to direct you to the right place. It contains your entrant number, allocated gate (for vehicles departing from Barratt Reserve, West Beach) and special grouping details (C, P, E, W, V, D or COM).

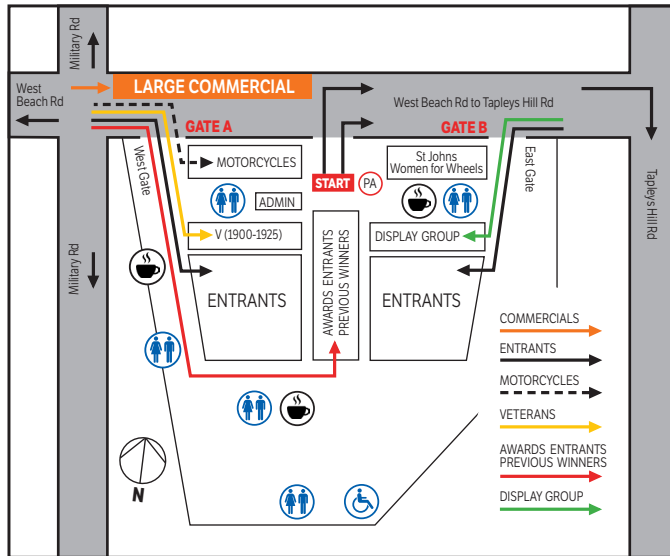
Please ensure that your Entrant Sticker is displayed on your left-hand headlight or the left-hand top corner of the windscreen of your vehicle and have this in place before arriving at the Start. For motorbike entrants or vehicles without a windscreen, please place the sticker where it fits best (for example, the stickers can be worn on the outside a jacket).

Vehicles without a visible Entrant Sticker will be denied access to the Start, Alternative Start and Finish.

If you lose or forget to place your Entrant Sticker, do the following:

- At the West Beach Start enter via Tapleys Hill Road, park off the reserve, notify a marshal and make your way on foot to the Information Tent.
- At the Alternative Start - Civic Park notify a marshal and follow their instructions.

THE START MAP



THE START

The Start site is located on Barratt Reserve, West Beach. The Reserve is located on the southern side of West Beach Road between Tapleys Hill Road and Military Road. Coffee and breakfast options available from 6.45 am.

There are two routes to the start:

- Via Military Road to West Beach Road for Gate A
- Via Tapleys Hill Road to West Beach Road for Gate B

Gates open at 6.30 am – to assist with traffic flow please adhere to the arrival times as outlined below.

West Beach Road is one-way from Military Road to Tapleys Hill Road from 7.45 am onwards

Any entrants arriving after 7.45 am on Tapleys Hill Road will be redirected to enter the Start via Military Road to West Beach Road through Gate A.

ARRIVAL TIME

PRESERVATION (P) + CONCOURS (C) + ELECTRIC VEHICLES (E) + PREVIOUS AWARD WINNERS (W)

Must arrive by 7.30 am via gate A.

COMMERCIAL VEHICLES (COM)

Arrive via Military Road by 8.00 am. You will be directed to park on the NORTH Carriageway of West Beach Road, facing EAST.

DISPLAY VEHICLES (D)

Must arrive by 7.45 am via Gate B.

MOTORCYCLES + VEHICLES MANUFACTURED 1900-1925 (V)

Enter via Gate A between 6.30 am and 9.30 am. Vehicles 1900-1925 (V) can park in a designated V area which is close to the start line. Please let the marshals know if you wish to park with the main body of entrants instead.

ALL OTHER ENTRANTS

Gate A entrants – arrive between 6.30 - 9.30 am

Gate B entrants – arrive between 6.30 - 7.45 am

DEPARTURE TIME

The controlled departure of vehicles starts at 8:15 am. Vehicles will depart from Barratt Reserve turn right onto West Beach Road, then follow the official route. You will be directed to use both lanes of West Beach Road.

ALTERNATIVE START

The Alternative Start is located at Civic Park, Modbury. It is situated off North East Road, opposite Westfield Tea Tree Plaza. Gates open at 7.00 am. Community groups will be on hand to provide participants with tasty breakfast options and coffee.

Enter Civic Park from Montague Road located directly north of the park. Entry will be guided by marshals on the ground, through the carpark of the City of Tea Tree Gully Library (refer to map).

Vehicles will depart from Civic Park, turning left onto North East Road from 8.30 am.
